


Two Boats Are Better Than One

Jefferson Yachts, in Jeffersonville, Indiana, has made a name for itself as an importer of fine Asian-built yachts and sport boats. That tradition continues with the 35 Marlago sport series fishing boats, which come in cuddy and open-bow versions. Both are built on a 24-degree, deep-V hull with 12-degree pad keel and stepped transom, which offers improved performance and maneuverability. Speed, fuel economy and tow capability are enhanced by the boat's lightweight hull design. In fact, both versions can be towed behind a standard pickup truck.

The 35 Marlago Sport Cuddy is the newest of the two models and comes packed with a long list of creature comforts, including a cuddy with V-berth and a walk-in helm console with SeaLand VacuFlush head and sink with pull-out shower. But the cuddy version also is built with the sportfishing enthusiast in mind. It has the rod holders flush-mounted to the gunwale, molded nonskid deck and through-bolted hardware that the experienced angler demands. Owners can choose between high- or low-profile bow rails.

Air conditioning with shore power, Westerbeke generator, radar arch with folding bimini top and a polished stainless steel towing bracket are among the desirable options. The outboard power selection includes twin Yamaha four-strokes or HPDI

outboards from 225 to 300 horsepower, and twin Mercury Verado four-strokes from 225 to 275 horsepower.
